

Tunghai University Outstanding Student Organization and Volunteer Service Scholarship Guidelines

Approved by the Administrative Meeting on April 1, 2009

Amended and approved by the 113-02 Administrative Meeting on March 6, 2024

- Article 1 These Guidelines are established to promote the growth, innovation, and development of student organizations and volunteer teams; encourage students to apply their knowledge in service to society; enhance the quality of extracurricular activities; cultivate outstanding student leaders; and recognize individuals who have demonstrated excellence in student organization leadership and volunteer service.
- Article 2 Recipients of this scholarship shall be selected by the Outstanding Service Scholarship Selection Committee (hereinafter referred to as the "Selection Committee"). The Vice President of Student Affairs shall serve as the Chair of the Selection Committee, and the committee members shall consist of second-level administrators of the Office of Student Affairs. Scholarship recipients shall be publicly recognized each year, and their achievements shall be published in the University newsletter.
- Article 3 This scholarship consists of two categories: the Outstanding Student Organization Award and the Outstanding Volunteer Service Award. Each applicant may apply for only one category. The selection criteria are as follows:
1. Outstanding Student Organization Award
 - (1) Outstanding performance while representing a student organization in on- or off-campus activities.
 - (2) Demonstrated leadership as a student organization officer through the development and implementation of work plans that significantly enhance the quality of activities.
 - (3) Outstanding performance as a student organization officer with concrete accomplishments.
 - (4) Leadership of or participation in the University's student

organization evaluation, resulting in a Grade A rating or above.

(5) Organization of outstanding campus activities or other distinguished achievements in student organization service.

2. Outstanding Volunteer Service Award

(1) Outstanding performance while representing a volunteer team in on- or off-campus activities.

(2) Demonstrated leadership as a volunteer team officer through the development and implementation of work plans that significantly enhance the quality of activities.

(3) Outstanding performance as a volunteer team officer with concrete accomplishments.

(4) Completion of volunteer training and accumulation of more than 80 hours of volunteer service on or off campus.

(5) Organization of outstanding campus service activities or other distinguished achievements in volunteer service.

Applicants who meet the above criteria shall submit the required documents to the Division of Extra-curricular Activities during the annual application period. The Division shall compile the applications and forward them to the Selection Committee for review.

Article 4 The number of scholarship recipients and the total scholarship amount shall be determined and announced in accordance with the University's annual budget.

Article 5 These Regulations shall take effect upon approval by the Administrative Council.
