

THU Regulations for the Establishment and Supervision of Student Government Organizations

Approved by the 7th Administrative Affairs Meeting on February 27, 2002

Approved by the 151st University Council on March 19, 2002

Amended and approved by the 8th Administrative Affairs Meeting on November 11, 2020

Amended and approved by the 225th University Council on December 22, 2020

- Article 1 To strengthen education outcomes, support student self-governance, cultivate students' democratic literacy, promote harmony on campus, facilitate communication, and uphold a culture of service, these regulations are established in accordance with Article 33 of the University Act and Article 32 of Tunghai University's organization charter.
- Article 2 Students of the university may establish student government organization in accordance with these regulations and serve as ex officio members of these organizations.
- Article 3 Student government organization established in accordance with these regulations shall represent students in exercising their rights of self-governance and handle matters related to students' learning, life, and interests on campus.
- Article 4 The establishment, management, and dissolution of student government organization shall be carried out in accordance with relevant THU regulations.
- Article 5 Student government organization shall comply with the university's rules and relevant laws, and shall accept oversight and support from the Division of Extra-curricular Activities of the Office of Student Affairs.
- Article 6 The finances of student government organization shall be handled according to the following principles:
- 1) Student government organization may collect membership fees from their members.
 - 2) When soliciting funds from outside the university, they shall do so in the name of the university or in collaboration with fundraising organizations that have obtained permits, and shall obtain fundraising permits in accordance with relevant regulations of the Charity Donations Destined For Social Welfare Funds Implementation Regulations before proceeding.
 - 3) The funds of student government organization shall be managed and allocated by themselves, and their utilization shall be carefully planned and disclosed to members regularly; when necessary, student government organization shall accept audits from supervisory units.
 - 4) The use and disbursement of subsidies for student government organization shall comply with THU's accounting regulations and relevant laws.
- Article 7 Matters related to venue use, equipment borrowing, and posters of student government organization shall be handled in accordance with extra-curricular regulations and guidelines.
- Article 8 The legal responsibilities related to publications of student government organization shall be borne by the organization and its members.
- Article 9 Student government organization may appoint representatives to attend or observe relevant meetings in accordance with THU regulations.
- Article 10 Student government organization shall participate in various seminars and visits organized by THU to enrich their understanding of self-governance, management competency, and negotiation skills.
- Article 11 Individuals and responsible persons of student government organization who

violate university rules and relevant laws may be subject to legal responsibilities and repercussions according to specific circumstances.

Article 12 The Regulations herein shall be promulgated upon approval by the Administrative Affairs Meeting and University Council and archived by MOE.
